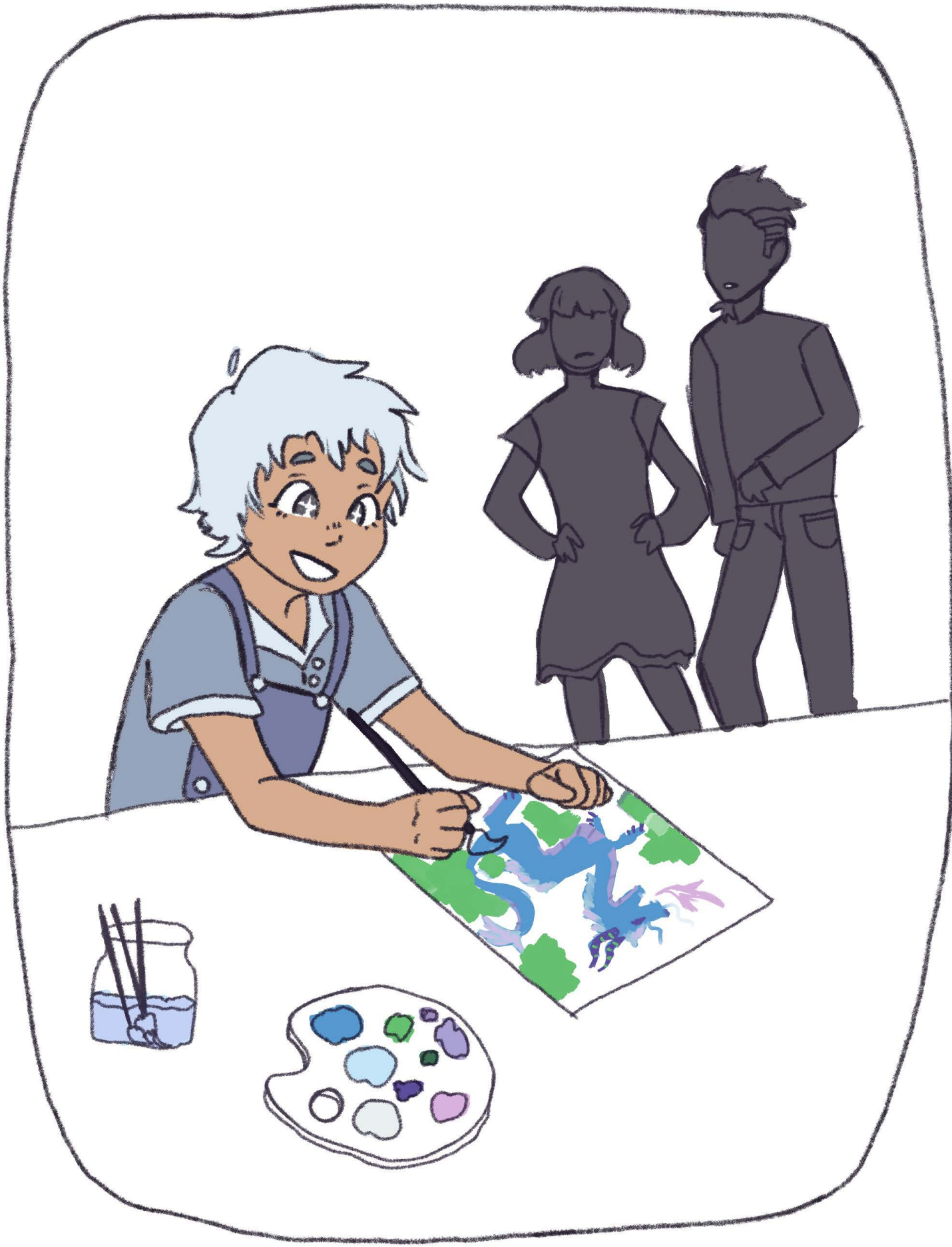

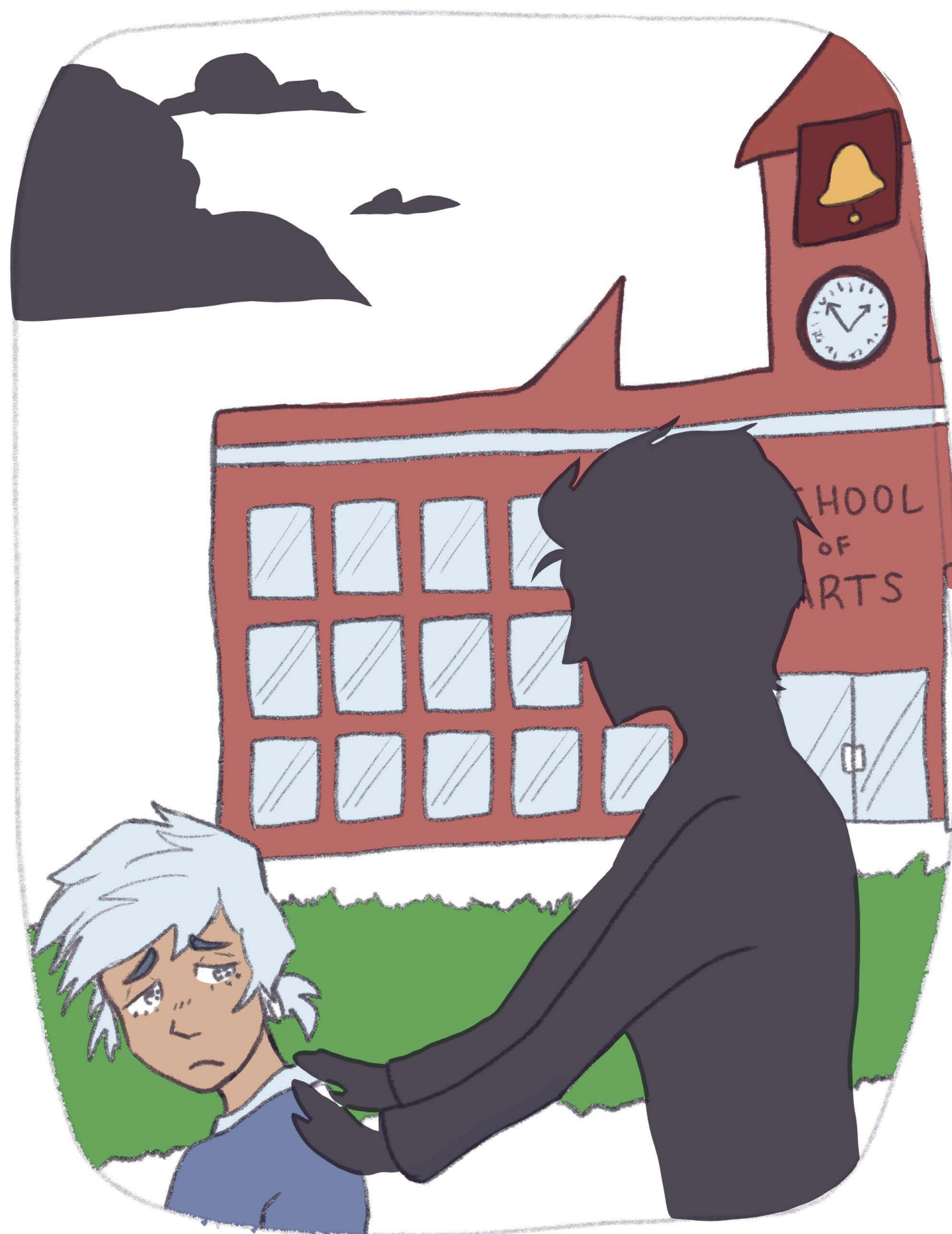
So many times are you told 'no'.

...you finally stand up for your beliefs, for your goals.

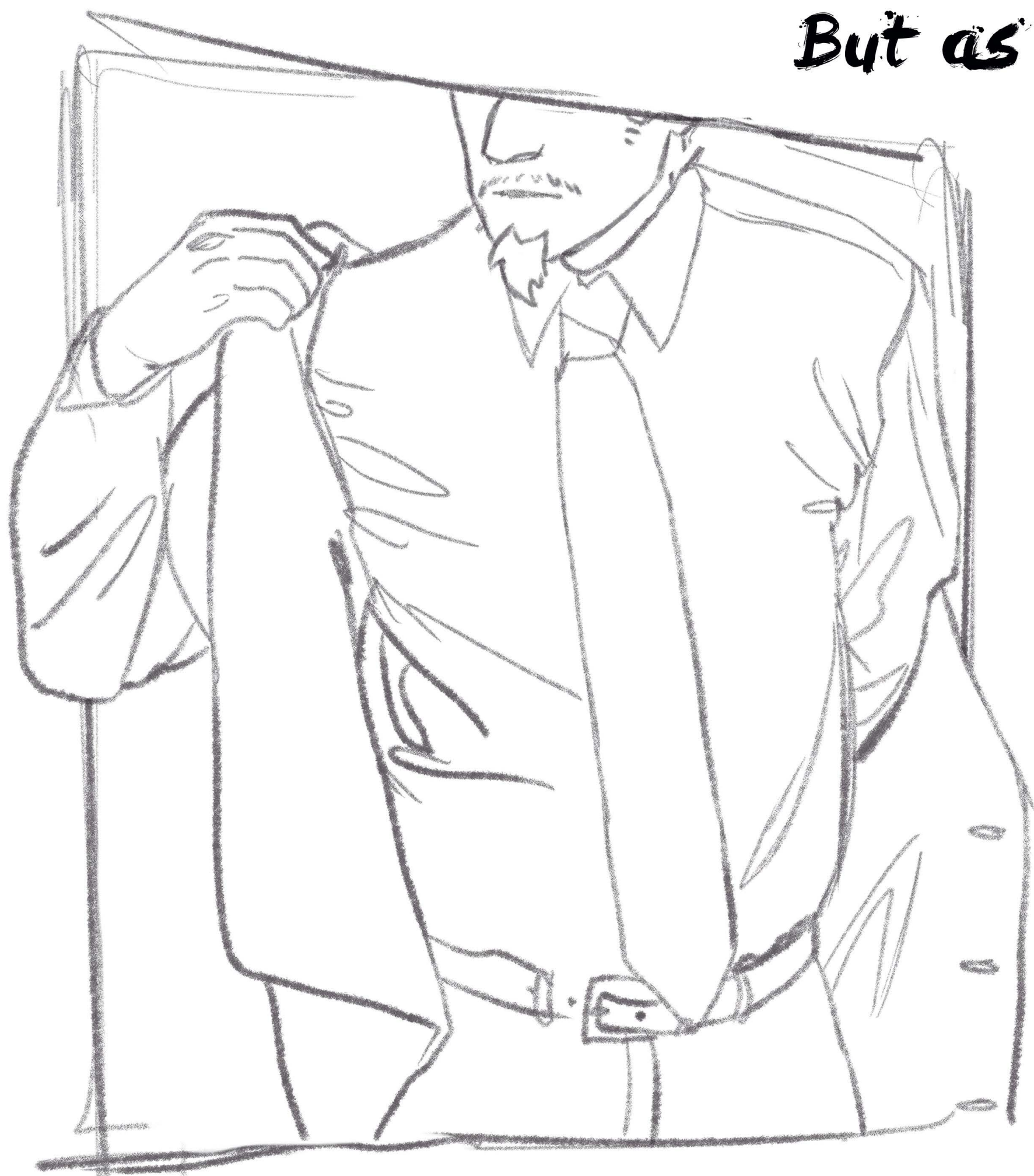


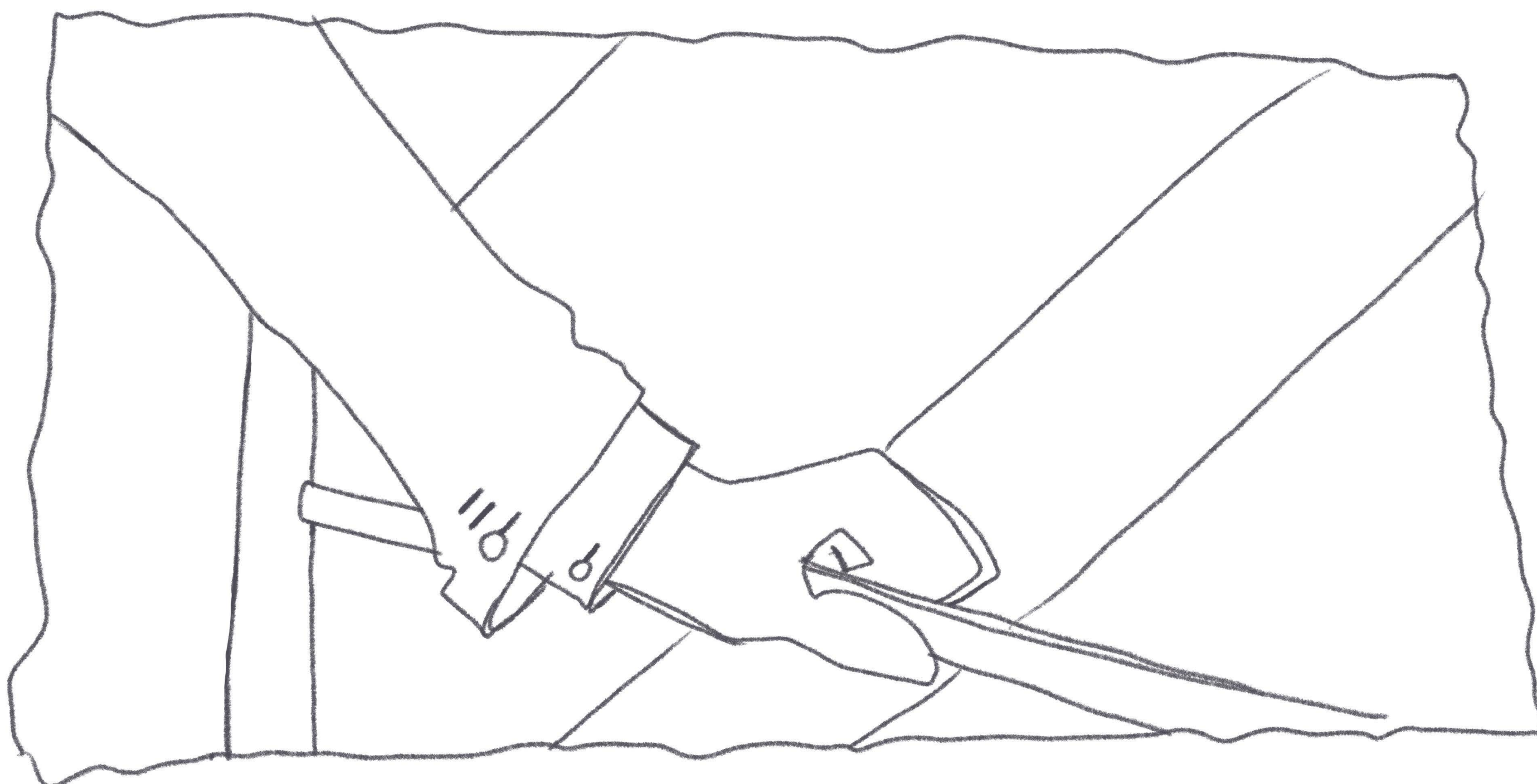
