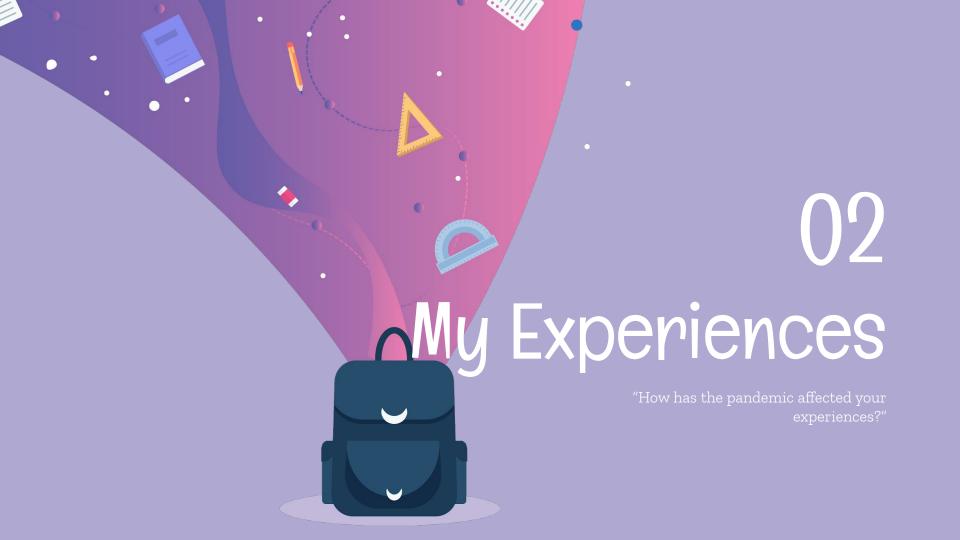
Mhat I've Learned
